from rickets. Rickets is a childhood bone disease caused by extreme vitamin deficiency. Although it is rare in industrialized nations, it is still common in developing countries. Bill Jr. brought our medical team to intervene, but by the time they arrived at the village, the child had died.

The Gideons distributed Bibles while we served food. The Gospel was preached and God's love was manifested." Pastor Thervil has an active church and school. He has a radio station where he broadcasts his Gospel sermons to the outlying villages.

Our clinic and Haitian medical staff provide much needed care for our sponsored children. When children need to be hospitalized, we are blessed to partner with King's Hospital. Recently Suzanne, our clinic supervisor, gave us an itemized bill from King's Hospital for the month. The bill was for children who were treated at the hospital. The bill came to \$540. We are able to help because of your sponsorship payment that includes \$5 for medical help. Last month, Michena DeClasse (*above with her sister and Bill Jr.*) was able to have surgery for a bone deformity. Your help is greatly appreciated.
