The demonstrations that Haiti has experienced this year have made necessities like food and water more expensive. Many families have to buy water for drinking and washing. The clinic treated people for issues related to lack of clean water.

The Medical Team saw 400 people during the trip. They held clinics at two of our sponsored schools. They also worked several days from the Campus Clinic. On the last day, families from the local community came to be seen. The families expressed how grateful they were for the help. It renewed their hope that someone cares.

We care. We are concerned for their physical and spiritual wellbeing. We gave children and families tracts in Creole and shared the Gospel. Our desire is that the Haitian people will be well and be saved.
