



Your prayers and support for this ministry are a crucial part of this success. Since it began, our Founders' Challenge fund has given us the resources we need to operate on the field.



Food Has Been Given, More Food Is Needed

For the past month, school has been suspended in Haiti because of COVID-19. In April, we used the funds that provide the school meals and bought beans and rice for the sponsored children. Our sponsorship crew went to each school and gave the children food to bring home to their families. The response from the families was incredible.

We have many children who attend our schools who are not sponsored. Their families have been affected financially by the Coronavirus too. We would like to give food to these families also.

It will cost \$2,000 per school to provide food for the remaining families. We have 7 schools who have not yet receive food from the effort we started last year. Your special offerings will be a blessing to many. Food is so important. It is no wonder why Jesus identified His life-saving power with food. In John 6:35, Jesus said, "I am the bread of life:"



How Is My Sponsored Child?




For the past month, our clinic crew has been visiting schools and checking the sponsored children. In particular, they have been checking to see if any child is sick or has a fever.
