Beginning in March, gangs started attacking the Port au Prince airport and the surrounding neighborhoods. These attacks caused the Cazeau police to react with force and push them back. The gangs used property walls to hide from the police. So the police began demolishing these walls all over the community.

As a part of this effort, the walls protecting the Cazeau church were also demolished. The gangs are gone from Cazeau. But, the church property is still exposed and vulnerable. Young men come onto the property at all hours and cause trouble. Because of the disruption the congregation cannot meet in the church.
