## The New Mission To Haiti School



Haiti has experienced a lot of change over the past couple of years. Gangs have taken over certain regions which has altered how we access the churches and schools we have partnered with for decades. Thankfully we have been able to continue supporting the schools and churches. But we began to feel that the Lord was using these circumstances to lead us to expand our vision. Since last year, new families have been flooding into the neighborhoods around the mission campus. We

prayed and felt the Lord was leading us into a new effort to reach these families.

The New Mission To Haiti School on the mission campus will be a complete ministry hub. Our vision is to have preschool through high school grades, a vocational school and a school of ministry to train young people for full-time service. This new school will establish a pattern that our partnering schools can follow. Our vision is to start with young children and train them to become leaders in Haiti.

Last year, we received several unexpected offerings that became the seeds to plant this new ministry. It was a confirmation of the vision God has given us.

Phase one is the new preschool facility that will accommodate up to 100 preschoolers. We are trusting God that what He started will be finished.

It will cost \$60,000 to complete the preschool construction. Our desire is to finish by the end of the year. Thank you for helping!
