Work On The New School Continues

Construction on the New Mission To Haiti School is going well. The basic structures of the preschool classrooms, pavillion, bathrooms and offices have been built. The workmen also installed a new gate where the children will enter and exit each day. The more we see the work progress, the more excited everyone becomes.

Included with the new school will be a solar powered well. This new well will be 200 feet deep. It will have a six inch casing to accommodate a solar powered water pump and an electric pump. The pumps will provide clean water to a 1000 gallon reservoir. This reservoir will be placed on a tower and provide fresh water to the new preschool and clinic. When the main school is built, it will provide water for those facilities also.

The solar pump will be used most of the time. It will provide a continual source of fresh water without the need for a generator or fuel. We also plan to power the buildings with solar power so that the buildings can operate as simply as possible.
